The Starkville Main Street Association will host the 2022 Souper Bowl on **Saturday, January 22, 2022, from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.** outside on Downtown Main Street in conjunction with the Frostbite. Rain Location TBA.

Restaurant Participation Requirements:

Make at least **8** gallons of soup. *Soup must be something that is specially prepared, unique and different than a soup on your normal menu.* SOUPS MUST BE OF A LIQUID CONSISTENCY. Please do not create pasta, meat, or other non-liquid dishes as to ensure the voting is kept fair.

- Participant location will be designated on a 1st come, 1st serve basis throughout main street. **Each restaurant is required to provide everything needed to participate — decorations, warming trays, serving utensils, etc.** 1 6 foot folding table & 10x10 tailgate tent will be provided, as well as small serving bowls, spoons, and napkins. **Electricity is available but you must bring your own extension cords and power strips. Restaurants are encouraged to bring single eye or portable burners. Please let staff know if you require electricity. Start time is at 11:00 a.m. and all participants must be ready to serve by 10:30 a.m. Setup begins at 9:30 a.m.**

The main idea behind the event is to have attendees taste as many soups as they can and vote on the best soup. We will award a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place based on the attendees' ballots and a "Best of Show". Best of Show will be based on taste as well as booth design, and vendor participation.

Our goal for this event is to represent the best of Starkville, so explore your creative edge and prepare a soup recipe that showcases your restaurant and will be memorable and talked about until next year. With the voting and awarding of the Souper Bowl Champion, we encourage everyone to put their best foot forward through presentation and taste. Only equipment needed to keep the soup and other complimentary ingredients hot or cold will be allowed, so all soup and complimentary ingredients must be prepared beforehand and brought to the event. SOUPS MUST BE OF A LIQUID CONSISTENCY. Please do not create pasta, meat, or other non-liquid dishes as to ensure the voting is kept fair.
